PIC Tags!

At Town and Country Rural Supplies our aim is to have the shortest turn around on **PIC tag orders** as possible. Some things that slow down the process are:

- Incorrect PIC numbers
- PIC Tags ordered under the wrong name.

When placing a PIC tag order either in store or over the phone, you will need your PIC number and the name of the person who the PIC number is registered to (the PIC Manager).

If you are unsure who the PIC manager is for your property you can contact the Local Land Services (LLS) on 1300 795 299, they will ask for your PIC number so have it ready. The LLS can also supply you with PIC certificate for your records. You can register multiple managers; this has to be done in writing to the LLS at admin.ct@lls.nsw.gov.au
