<p>DAY -1</p>	<p>Cluster Phase</p> <p>Use about 20kgs of grain (can be fermented) at sites of pig activity to cluster pigs to the site</p> <p>Do not place hoppers unless pigs are visiting</p>	<p>Grain Only</p> <p>Pigs quickly learn to eat from the hopper.</p>	<p>DAYS 2-4</p>
<p>DAY -1</p>	<p>Cluster Phase</p> <p>If pigs are present they will feed repeatedly at night.</p> <p>Try to estimate pig numbers based on consumption of grain</p>	<p>Placebo Phase</p> <p>Close lids and fill hopper with grain.</p> <p>Then if grain is taken fill with Placebo (unpoisoned) HOGGONE® bait</p>	<p>DAYS 5-6</p>
<p>DAY 1</p>	<p>Grain Only</p> <p>Secure hoppers to the ground.</p> <p>Fill with grain with lids propped open</p>	<p>Toxic Phase</p> <p>Pigs that are used to eating the placebo bait will readily take poison bait on the first night</p> <p>Pick up dead pigs next morning, if required</p>	<p>DAYS 7-8</p>
